IATI & Bahrain FinTech Bay MOU Joined by the Bahrain Ambassador to Israel

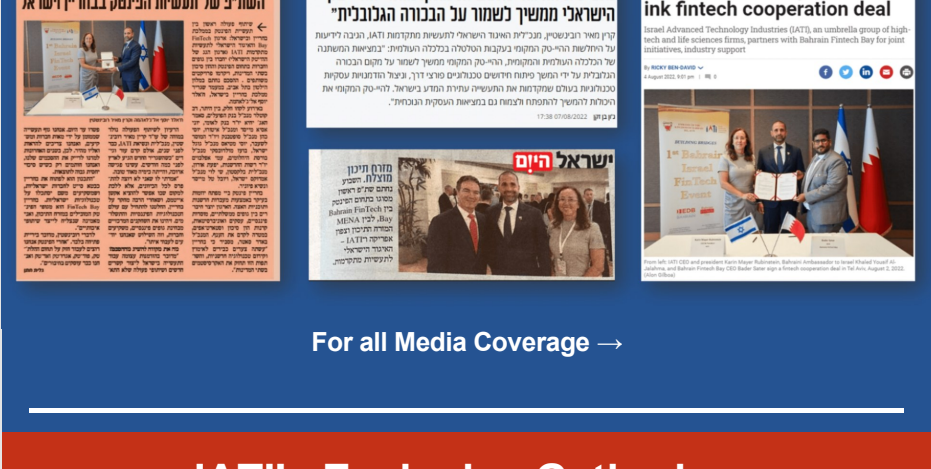
