#### Update - H1 2023 Highlights



We are pleased to publish IATI H1 Update – Israel's Life Science Industry Report, The Report focuses on the capital raising of life sciences companies in Israel and presents interim data for 2023 in preparation for the publication of a comprehensive Report during the month of November 2023 at MIXiii Health—Tech.IL.



This update indicates a decrease in investments in life sciences companies in Israel; In the first six months of 2023, in which approximately 1.4 billion dollars were invested, a decrease of 40% compared to the corresponding period in 2022; About half a billion dollars were raised by Israeli companies on the US stock exchanges, twice as much as in 2022 as a whole; an increase in the average amount per transaction as well.

Our IATI Foreign Ambassadors Forum in Israel (IATI FAF), held its quarterly meeting at Tel Aviv Sourasky Medical Center.


Over 50 Ambassadors and economic attaches participated in the forum meeting.



OECD releases Pillar Two model rules for domestic implementation of 15% global minimum tax

Following a meeting we convened with the government (Budget Division, State Revenue Manager and the Innovation Authority) & the IATI MNC Forum meeting, on the subject of the OECD's reform of international taxation (Pillar 2)

pillar 2: one of the pillars of the international tax reform, establishes a minimum global corporate tax of 15%, which will apply to international groups with a revenue turnover of at least 750 million euros.

We held an intensive Zoom meeting with the participation of approximately 60 Global companies, IATI members, to evaluate potential solution to deal best with this reform.

### Awarding a shield of honor to former U.S. Ambassador to Israel Thomas R. Nides




